General Facts about the English Stream:

- All subjects except for German, Afrikaans and IsiXhosa are taught in English
- The learners are examined by an independent body: the Independent Matriculation Board

General Facts about the English Stream:

- Tertiary institutions are not allowed to give learners who matriculated with the IEB preferential treatment
- In the treaty between Germany and South Africa, the IEB was chosen as the examining body for German Schools

General Facts about the English Stream:

The IEB only regulates Grade 12

The IEB Assessment in Grade 12 consists of:

- Portfolio works
- Prelim Exam
- Oral mark

and the

- Final Exam.

Assessment:

Grade 10: Introduction Phase for learners

- > MINIMUM OF 7 subject required
- **new:** learning content needs to be retained for longer
- (Exam at the end of the year includes content of the whole year)
- ESTABLISHING ROUTINES
- Absenteeism needs to be excused in writing to the class teacher and for every test and exam a doctor's note needs to be provided

 - It consists of:
 - written exam
 - oral exam
- > The DSD 2 certifies that the learner's language proficiency is adequate to study at a university with German as the medium of instruction.
