

## PARKING/TRAFFIC GUIDELINES

We have limited parking on the DSK school premises, and whilst that circumstance prevails a large measure of thought, care and consideration from all members of the DSK community will help to alleviate the situation. Please lead by being the positive role-model you would like others to follow. With that in mind, please:

1. Be aware of and follow the suggested one-way system during peak times.
2. Do not drop off, pick up, park or wait on the pedestrian crossings – this also applies to the adjacent areas with zigzag lines.
3. Do not park or wait at intersections, especially Bay View and Upper Albert, as this seriously disrupts traffic flow.
4. Remember that the bus bay is reserved for the school busses only, until 08:00.
5. Allow adequate time for your journey.
6. Bear in mind that the whole area around the DSK is a school zone, with many small and easily-distracted children. **SLOW DOWN!**

With regard to parking, please note:

1. The **Parking** area inside the Main Gate is reserved for staff members and visitors.
2. The **Lower Parking area** (parents' parking) adjacent to the Main Gate has 10 spaces marked and reserved for teachers in the upper section. These spaces are for the exclusive use of teaching staff until 13:00 – that means no stopping, waiting, dropping-off or parking. One additional bay in the lower section is reserved for motorcycles.
3. The **Lower Parking** areas marked by yellow lines adjacent to the steps and by the gate leading down to the sports field are to be kept clear in order to provide easy and unobstructed pedestrian access.
4. The speed limit throughout the DSK campus property is **15 kph**.

With regard to **pedestrian traffic**, please remember to always use the two crossings that are either side of the Main Gate and to enter the DSK property through the pedestrian entrance rather than via the roadway.

Additionally, please note that **dogs are not permitted** on the entire DSK property. So, if you walk your child to school with your dog you will need to stay outside the gates, and if you drive to school, please make sure your dog does not escape when the car door opens.
